Abel Zalcborg began working in the office furniture industry in 1977 and founded Office Furniture Marketing, Inc. in 1986 as a national sales managing group for small-sized manufacturers. In 1995, he officially started OFM, Inc. to manufacture, import and distribute OFM brand of products to office furniture dealers, government, schools and health care suppliers.

In 2005, Abel, on behalf of OFM, was awarded the Triangle Business Journal Fast 50 award, which recognizes the fastest growing private companies in the Triangle. He has also won numerous “salesman of the year” awards throughout his career.

While he has spent much of his career in the office furniture business, his professional interests do not end there.
